The Parents Right to Know Act, the Prevention First Act and the Emergency Contraception in the Emergency Room bill have been introduced in other states and are part of a coordinated effort to reduce the need for abortion by providing information and increasing access to reproductive health care services.

- **The Parents Right to Know Act** requires schools to provide parents with information about the type of sex education their children are receiving (i.e. abstinence-only or comprehensive) in their school and requires principals to mail a notice to parents regarding the provision of abstinence-only curriculum.
- **The Prevention First Act** includes three components to reduce the need for abortion by increasing access to emergency contraception, increasing access to family planning funding and access points and requires comprehensive sex education in public schools.
- **The Emergency Contraception in the Emergency Room** bill requires certain medical facilities to provide information about EC to victims of sexual assault.
